The Visionary Leadership Team (VLT) last met on 1st February 2010. We discussed....

- how output of the boiler has been increased to enable the church to be warm.
 - how the Secondary glazing is being started 2/2/10 and the wall is taking shape in the community room.
 - Becky's proposal for a gap year student to work alongside children/youth/worship as an intern. This would involve minimal financial expenditure for the church, but would provide many benefits. David and staff members were given the 'go-ahead' to progress this to the next stages. The next step is to find host families.
 - data protection and how it affects us as a church. Anthony Haysom gave an excellent presentation about the safeguards we need to consider putting in place.
 - the Bishops unique proposal for Tim Rose and his future at St Saviours. We all agreed unanimously that David should go to the Bishop and say "yes please!" David also wanted to let the church family know asap and would add all the information to his Feb 'What's on the Vicars Mind'.
 - Barbie's financial report and we all recognised how hard Sheila has worked on getting the accounts updated
 - next years VLT and who was willing to stand again at the AVM on Tuesday 20th April. A slide will be made for the church to see who is willing to stand well in advance of the AVM. Shirley announced that she will be standing down in April from her roles as Chair of the VLT, Warden and Children's Advocate
 - giving a donation to Open Door Church to thank them for letting us use their building for Wednesday services and Noah's Ark on Thursday mornings. There have been no restrictions on our usage and Open Door church has been very accommodating. A gift of £1K was agreed upon.
